

0666: Wholesale Wheeling Service Tariff (100-999 kw)

Applicability:

Wholesale transmission and distribution service using the Wells Rural Electric Co. (WREC) facilities. Service under this tariff is Wholesale Wheeling Service and is not available for Retail Service.

Availability:

Available throughout WREC's service territory to wholesale providers of electric power and subject to WREC's Rule 9 line extension policy.

Type of Service:

This service will be supplied at a single point of origin and measured at the point of delivery with one meter at WREC's available transmission and distribution voltages.

Conditions of Service:

1. If adequate facilities are not in place at the time service is requested, WREC will construct new facilities, or alter existing facilities as necessary, pursuant to WREC's Rule 9 line extension policy.
2. All facilities altered or constructed pursuant to WREC's Rule 9 shall remain the property of the WREC.
3. Wheeling customer is not a cooperative member of WREC but is subject to all Rules and Regulations of WREC.
4. Maximum wheeling demand is to be specified in the request for wheeling service.
5. Wheeling path point of origin and point of delivery is to be specified in the request for service.
6. Demand rate for exceeding the maximum demand is 3 times the Wheeling Tariff rate.
7. Wheeling service is subject to termination if the maximum demand is exceeded.

Rates:

Transmission Wheeling

Monthly Rate

1. Service Charge: Same as Rate Class 0006 Service Charge.
2. Demand Rate: \$0.10 per kW 11 month ratchet.

Distribution Wheeling

Monthly Rate

1. Service Charge: Same as the Service Charge for Commercial or Industrial Service equivalent to the requested maximum wheeling service.
2. Demand Rate: \$1.29 per kW 11 month ratchet.

Minimum Monthly Charge

The minimum monthly charge shall be 2 times the Service Charge.

Losses:

Customers taking service under this tariff shall compensate WREC for losses resulting from such service.

Metered quantities shall be adjusted to reflect the following loss factors:

1. Transmission loss factor 1.02
2. Distribution loss factor 1.05

The loss factor may be adjusted by WREC from time to time as the losses occurring on the WREC's facilities change.

- **EFFECTIVE DATE:** The first billing date following December 1, 2017
